


Organized 1959

FOPL DONATES \$30,000 TO FULFILL FALL WISH LIST FOR ORANGE PUBLIC LIBRARIES

At the October 10 Orange City Council meeting, FOPL Board President, **Kathleen Stevens**, presented Orange Public Library Director, **Dave Curtis**, with a check for \$30,000. This money was raised through book sales, membership dues, donations and bookstore sales.

The Fall 2023 Wish List included

- \$2,000 for Employee Appreciation Program
- \$750 for Día de los Ninos, Día de los Libros Program
- \$1,000 for El Modena Gardens and Patio Seating
- \$2,000 for iPads for Volunteer Sign-In Stations
- \$20,000 to go towards El Modena Community Room Equipment
- \$4,250 for Continuing Refresh of the 3 Library Locations

FOPL HAS AN ONLINE BOOKSTORE

Friends of Orange Public Library raises grant money for the Library by selling donated books, movies and music through our Library bookstore as well as our seasonal books sales. But did you know that we also sell books across the country through our store on the Internet? Our Internet store has three locations: Amazon, Biblio and eBay. Our inventory of nearly 1,000 titles covers a wide range of subjects and authors. Vintage books from the 19th and 20th centuries, signed first editions, collectibles, textbooks, art books, comics, and boxed sets as well as brand new books are sold. Prices for our books range from \$15 - \$20 to hundreds of dollars for rare and unique items. Recently, we have listed gently used book sets from the American Girls Doll Collection on eBay.

On our Biblio site, we have listed first editions signed by the authors including Dean Koontz, Michael Connelly, Janet Evanovich, C. J. Box, J. A. Jance, and Michael Caine as well as vintage collectors items.



CALLING ALL JANE AUSTEN FANS

Join us at the Woman's Club of Orange on Thursday, January 18 at 6:30 PM for a talk with Dr. Lynda Hall about the life and writings of Jane Austen.

Lynda Hall is Associate Professor and Chair of English at Chapman University, specializing in Austen and the English Gothic Novel. She has served as a Traveling Lecturer, has presented at nine conferences for the Jane Austen Society of North America, and has essays in various journals, including *Persuasions, Nineteenth Century Gender Studies, Eighteenth Century Fiction,* and *Texas Studies in Language and Learning,* as well as chapters in various books on Austen. She published *Jane Austen and "Value:" Settling, Speculating, and Superfluity* in 2017.


